London Space Network Code of Conduct

All participants at London Space Network events are required to agree with the following code of conduct. Participants include attendees, sponsors, and organisers. London Space Network organisers will enforce this code at events. We expect cooperation from all participants to help ensure a safe environment for everybody.

The London Space Network is dedicated to providing a harassment-free event experience for everyone, regardless of gender, gender identity and expression, age, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, ethnicity, religion (or lack thereof), or technology choices. We do not tolerate harassment of event participants in any form. Sexual language and imagery is not appropriate for any event venue, including talks, workshops, parties, Twitter, and other online media.

London Space Network event attendees agree to:

- Treat one another with respect and consideration.
- Refrain from personal attacks directed toward other participants.

If you are being harassed, notice that someone else is being harassed, or have any other concerns, please contact a London Space Network organiser immediately.

The London Space Network's Commitment:

London Space Network event organisers will investigate all incidents reported at the event with discretion and confidentiality. If an attendee is asked to stop harassing behavior, they are expected to comply immediately. If deemed necessary, London Space Network event organisers reserve the right to take additional actions to ensure the conference is a safe environment for all participants, including expulsion of offenders from London Space Network events in its entirety or in part.

The London Space Network event organisers will be happy to help attendees contact hotel/venue security or local law enforcement or otherwise assist those experiencing harassment to feel safe for the duration of London Space Network events.

We expect participants to follow these rules during London Space Network events.
